Advent Colour and Symbols

Purple is used in Advent because it preparation symbolizes and representing a time of both reflection and the anticipation of Christ's arrival. We are encouraged to reflect on our inner lives and prepare our hearts for the Christmas celebration. As a season of preparation, Advent shares similarities with Lent. another penitential season where purple is also used. Purple also has strong links with royalty; the one who will be born in poverty will come again as King.



The candles in an Advent Wreath are therefore often purple – until the 3rd Sunday is reached. At this point, over halfway through, there is a little light relief, and rose can replace the purple. Then it's back to purple for the 4th Sunday and white for Christmas Day, the arrival of The Light himself.


Digital Giving

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus according to Matthew

Glory to you, O Lord!

'But about that day and hour no one knows, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. For as the days of Noah were, so will be the coming of the Son of

Man. For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day Noah entered the ark, and they knew nothing until the flood came and swept them all away, so too will be the coming of the Son of Man. Then two will be in the field; one will be taken and one will be left. Two women will be grinding meal together; one will be taken and one will be left.
